

It has been a successful year for the Darien Land Trust (DLT) as we continue our efforts to preserve open space in Darien. The DLT now permanently preserves 207 acres, providing all of Darien with beautiful vistas and environmentally diverse habitats. In December 2015, we added our most recent property, 2.0 acres of coastal meadow on Long Neck Point – our first property in that part of Darien! Our search for land to conserve never ends, and if you have interest in preserving your land or are aware of parcels that we should consider, please contact us.

Our Stewardship group continues their active agenda – if you've driven by Waterbury Field you've seen the fruits of their labors with the river birch plantings and the native plant garden.

Our Outreach committee has really ramped up their game, with a fantastic Farm to Table Dinner and a very well received Trails Discovery Day in Dunlap and Selleck's Woods, an event that is targeted towards families with younger children. These events are just a sample of the numerous things Darien Land Trust is doing to better engage with our members and Town residents. We invite you to join us for our 2016 Annual Meeting, which will be held at 5:00 pm on Sunday, November 13 at the Wee Burn Country Club. We emphasize the importance of taking a "connected" view of the land we all preserve, whether it be woodland, meadow, river, pond or coastal habitats within our Town or a broader view within the regions in which we live. Our speaker will be Mary Ellen Lemay, who is Coordinator of the Fairfield County Regional Conservation Partnership. She will speak about how best to protect priority habitats and connectivity corridors within Fairfield County.

At our Annual Meeting we will also be saying goodbye to Karen Calby and Phil Meyer, who have both made tremendous contributions to the Darien Land Trust. Finally, we are very excited to be voting on the nominations of Michelle Imbrogno, MJ McNulty, John O'Brien and Anne Walker to join the Board. Please join us for what promises to be a very interesting evening.



DARIEN LAND TRUST ANNUAL REPORT

2016 - A Year of Accomplishments

Each year, the Darien Land Trust Board of Trustees devotes many volunteer hours to preserve and restore our land, connect with our community and gather support for our 207 acres of open space. And 2016 was no different as our volunteers worked hard in the following areas to continue the health and long-term viability of the DLT.

PRESERVE:

• The Darien Land Trust accepted a two-acre Conservation Easement with donations from neighbors on Long Neck Point. This will be maintained as a coastal meadow and permanently preserved for future generations.

RESTORE:

- We actively manage our properties to improve wildlife habitats and bio-diversity and in 2016 continued to plant native trees and a native pollinator garden at Waterbury Field on Hollow Tree Ridge Road and in our Nature Preserves at Dunlap Woods and Tokeneke Trail.
- We increased the number of bee-hives on DLT properties to a total of 15 hives.

CONNECT:

- We hosted community-wide events at the Darien Library to educate and inform. We co-sponsored two documentaries and the lecture" Know your Trees" presented by Michael Wojtech.
- We gratefully accepted the help of scores of enthusiastic volunteers to help improve our properties. Volunteers from the Noroton Presbyterian Church, Whole Foods Market, Eagle Scouts from Troops 35 and 53 and the Friends of Selleck's Woods all contributed to these efforts and gave back to the land.

SUPPORT:

- Friends of the DLT opened their homes for evenings of fellowship that provided opportunities to explain our land management practices and to connect with our members and neighbors.
- The DLT was selected to be the recipient of the Darien Whole Foods Market 5% day which allowed us to receive a generous donation and to engage with customers by offering samples of honey from our meadow hives.
- Our second Farm to Table Dinner was a great success with more than 225 diners enjoying a perfect summer night under the stars.
- Our Trails Discovery Day in Dunlap and Selleck's Woods provided a Nature Trail for families to explore the woods and enjoy animal exhibits.

SUSTAIN:

- In 2016 we launched the first stage of our Legacy Partners program to create a Land Endowment fund to support the Darien Land Trust in perpetuity. This will enable the DLT to take advantage of new land acquisitions should they arise and to support maintenance and special land conservation projects on our properties.
